The program nurtures, recruits, and trains women to build and maintain attractive, decent, healthy and affordable homes in their community. It is an opportunity for women to build for women.



Who We Are

Southern Crescent Habitat for Humanity (SCHFH) provides affordable homeownership opportunities for low to moderate income families, as well as home preservation to income qualified families, seniors, and veterans.

Habitat impacts hundreds of individuals a year in Clayton, Fayette, and Henry Counties through build, repair, and community projects.

Women, especially those who serve as head of their families and women of color, disproportionately face obstacles that make accessing decent, affordable housing seem impossible. At Habitat, we know that stable, affordable homeownership is transformative for all families.

Requirements for All Sponsor Logo Submissions

All sponsor logos submitted for inclusion in SCHFH materials can be shared in either EPS or PDF formats. One version must be saved as a grayscale EPS or PDF file, with text converted to outlines.

Women Build FAQ

When is Women Build? The 2023 Women Build event will take place on May 2nd - 6th. When you register for Women Build as a team or individual, you select one available build date to participate in Women Build Month.

What kind of projects can I choose from? For Women Build 2023, we will have build opportunities on home repair projects throughout our service area and Habitat's new home build.

Please explain the \$100 per person registration cost? Where do all the funds raised go?

When do I need to raise them by? The funds raised through Women Build registration costs directly support the projects where Women Build takes place and cover essential project construction costs such as tools, building materials and supplies, permits, and safety equipment. Women Build participants also receive our infamous t-shirt, a catered lunch on site, and a small appreciation gift.

Participants can register a few different ways including a team sponsorship registration (paid in full), individual registration (paid in full), or through utilizing the provided Women Build 2023 crowdfunding platform to raise the registration and donations from friends, family, and colleagues. All registration minimums must be met in full by April 7th in order to participate.

Do I need construction experience? No, all skill levels are welcome for Women Build. All tools and training needed will be provided for you!

When is the last day I can register to participate? Women Build fills up quickly and build days are available until we sell out. Groups and sponsorships must be confirmed by 3/31/2023 for logo inclusion on signage and printed Women Build materials.

Can I register a team of 2 or a number that isn't 4, 10, or 20? Yes! You can register as an individu-al or create your own team of any size! Each participant must raise a minimum of \$100 to participate. Build days are available until we sell out.

How long is the build day? When you register for Women Build, you are registering for a single build day that is from 8am-3pm.
